Crowndale Foodservice Ltd is committed to achieving Net Zero emissions by 2050.

Baseline Emissions Footprint

Baseline emissions are a record of the greenhouse gases that have been produced in the past and were produced prior to the introduction of any strategies to reduce emissions. Baseline emissions are the reference point against which emissions reduction can be measured.

Additional details relating to the Baseline Emissions calculations.

Calculations below are based on the guidelines of the Greenhouse Gas Protocol Corporate Accounting and Reporting Standard (GHG Protocol).

Data collection and calculation

Co2 emissions were calculated using the company's consumption data and emission factors researched by ClimatePartner. Wherever possible, primary data were used. If no primary data were available, secondary data from highly credible sources were used. Emission factors were taken from scientifically recognised databases such as ecoinvent and DEFRA.

Operational system boundaries indicate which activities are covered by the carbon footprint. The various sources have divided into three scopes in accordance with GHG.

Protocol:

Scope 1 includes all emissions generated directly, for example by company-owned equipment or vehicles fleets.

Scope 2 lists emissions generated by purchased energy, for example electricity and district heating.

Scope 3 includes all other emissions that are not under direct corporate control, such as employee travel or product disposal.

Emissions Reduction Targets

Crowndale Foodservice Ltd commits to reduce absolute scopes 1 and 2 GHG emissions by 42% by 2029 from a 2024 base year. With regards to our scope 3 emissions, the majority of our suppliers are national or global companies with their own Carbon Reduction Plans in place. Our scope 3 emissions for purchased goods and services should reduce in line with these plans.

Carbon Reduction Projects

To meet our sustainability targets we have identified key projects that will enable us to reduce our emissions.

Scope 1+2

- Use renewable Energy Sources, switching to green electricity.
- Use more low-emission refrigerants
- Increase energy efficiency through newer equipment
- Optimise processes through new procedures, and improved operational activities

Scope 3

- Conserve resources, through avoidance such as making fewer trips, using less packaging and producing less waste.
- Use more low-emission raw material, such as regional and recycled materials
- Choose low emission options for daily activities, such as biking to work
- Engage with suppliers, encouraging suppliers to share knowledge and experience in implementing sustainability practices and solutions.
- Engage with employees by offering incentives to implement climate friendly measures, providing ongoing training opportunities.
